JUNIOR SAT DAY – WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4TH – The Ohio Department of Education provides the SAT to all juniors, free of charge. The SAT testing date will be on Wednesday, March 4th, with testing beginning at 7:30 am on that date. This is a mandatory test for all juniors, including students attending the LCJVS and CCP full-day students at both Lorain County Community College and BG-Firelands. Student in the other three grades will not have class that day at Firelands High School. Students in grades 9, 10, and 12 should use the day to shadow career interests, or make it a college visit day. The SAT should end that day about noon. They will be excused at that time. Lunch will be provided, but is not required. Students who receive testing accommodations will test that date until approximately 1:30 pm. Please check with your student to see if they will receive special testing accommodations. Students will begin to pre-register for the SAT in class, and counselors will travel to the JVS to pre-register our students who attend school there. Again, this is a mandatory test for all juniors, regardless of what school they attend (LCCC, FHS, LCJVS). Please contact our school counseling office if you need further details.

FALCON SHOWCASE - Come join us on Tuesday, March 10th for the Falcon Showcase, which is studentfocused and is a direct reflection of their hard work and dedication. This is an excellent opportunity for the community to see the quality instruction within our buildings, and what the students have produced.

ATHLETIC NEWS – TWO FALCON TEAMS ARE CHAMPS – The Wrestling team won the Lorain County League Championship this past weekend at Wellington. The Falcons dominated the field, easily outdistancing second place Keystone by 65 points. Individual LC8 Champions were 106 lbs – Ruben Pina-Lorenzana, 132 lbs – Payton Burgdorf, 145 lbs – Bryce Keown, and 152 lbs – Donald Crawford. Burgdorf was named MVP of the LC8, and finishes his senior year as a four-time league champion. FHS also had five runner-ups in Corey Newark, Connor Rogers, Ethan Tester, Luke Dempsey, and Seth Robinette, as the Falcons sent nine wrestlers to the Championship match last night. The Falcons will compete in the Sectional Wrestling Tournament at Bay High School on Saturday, February 29th, beginning at 9:30 am. The top four wrestlers in each weight class advance to the District Tournament at Norwalk High School on March 6th and 7th.

The LC8 Champion Lady Falcons will host East Technical this Thursday, February 20th in the Nest, beginning at 7 pm. The winner will move onto the District Semi-Finals at Elyria next week.

Finally, congratulations to Michael Smith as he qualified to the OHSAA District Bowling Tournament. Michael competed this afternoon at the District in Avon Lake, and is looking to advance to the State Bowling Tournament in Columbus on March 2nd.
