CCP, JUNIOR COLLEGE – PLANNING, & INCOMING FRESHMAN MEETINGS – TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 4TH – This Tuesday, the FHS Counseling Department will be hosting several meetings for students and parents. At 5:30, there is a College Planning meeting for Juniors and their parents, which will be held in the Library Media Center. At that same time, in the cafeteria, there is a meeting with Freshman parents about scheduling for next school year. Finally, at 6:30 pm, there is a College Credit Plus (CCP) meeting for all students and parents interested in enrolling in the program for 2020-21. That meeting will be in the Library Media Center. Come on out to FHS on Tuesday night for more information on any of these programs.

JUNIOR SAT DAY – WENDESDAY, MARCH 4TH – The Ohio Department of Education provides the SAT to all juniors, free of charge. The SAT testing date will be on Wednesday, March 4th, with testing beginning at 7:30 am on that date. This is a mandatory test for all juniors, including students attending the LCJVS and CCP full-day students at both Lorain County Community College and BG-Firelands. Student in the other three grades will not have class that day at Firelands High School. Students in grades 9, 10, and 12 should use the day to shadow career interests, or make it a college visit day. The SAT should end that day about noon. They will be excused at that time. Lunch will be provided, but is not required. Students who receive testing accommodations may test that date until approximately 1:30 pm. Please check with your student to see if they will receive special testing accommodations. Students will begin to pre-register for the SAT in class, and counselors will travel to the JVS to pre-register our students who attend school there. Again, this is a mandatory test for all juniors, regardless of what school they attend (LCCC, FHS, LCJVS). Please contact our school counseling office if you need further details.

OPEN ENROLLMENT NOW ON-LINE – MONDAY FEBRUARY 3RD at 7:30 AM - Starting Monday, February 3rd, Firelands will be accepting new K-12 open enrollment applications for the 2020-2021 school year. Parents from any school district in Ohio are welcome to apply, but space is limited and will be awarded on a first come, first served basis. Enrollment is tuition free, but parents must pay for all school fees if applicable. If a grade level closes, we will still encourage parents to complete the open enrollment application and we will maintain waiting lists until July 1st. On July 1st, open enrollment will end for the 2020-2021 school year. (Kindergartners must do the open enrollment application 1st, followed by kindergarten registration in March.)_RETURNING OPEN ENROLLMENT STUDENTS - If your child was open-enrolled this school year, you must request that they continue by filling out the quick online form. It will be found in the same location, on the "student registration" page of the Firelands website. You will receive confirmation of their continued open-enrollment by email from the Superintendent's Office.

She is another resource for our students and families to access in for the above supports.

In other words, Deanna provides individual, confidential help and support to students who deal with anxiety, depression, relationship struggles, school stress, and other mental health issues. Deanna provides a confidential, safe place to discuss concerns as well as explore solutions to cope with stressors. She is an excellent link to outside resources in the community, linking them to families in the district. She can also help facilitate communication between schools and families. OHSAA TOURNAMENT TIME – The Girls Basketball team earned the #3 seed and a first round bye in the Division II District Basketball tournament. They will be hosting the winner of the 1st round game between Fairview and East Technical on Thursday, February 20th at 7 pm. As a reminder, all passes are not good for OHSAA tournaments, even played at Firelands High School. Ticket prices at the gate are \$7 for adults and \$5 for students/senior citizens. Only OHSAA passes will be accepted for admission.

The Wrestling team will participate in the OHSAA Division II Dual Meet Tournament, with the Falcons wrestling in Brookside Region on Saturday, February 8th. The #7 seeded Falcons will take on #10 Cleveland Central Catholic, with the winner moving onto the Regional Quarter-Finals to take on #2 seeded Bay. The Regional Champion will be decided that day, with the Regional Champ moving onto the State Dual Meet Final Four in Columbus. Wrestling begins at 9 am on the eighth and will continue throughout the day. Regional ticket prices are \$8 for everyone, with only OHSAA accepted for admission.
