## FHS HIGHLIGHTS

FHS Highlights will be listed here each week to highlight different aspects of FHS Campus activities. Student achievements in the classroom, extra-curricular activities, and community events will be highlighted here, along with important information from both the FHS Main Office and the Athletic Department.

A GREAT FIRST WEEK-The students of FHS returned to school last week on Tuesday, August 30th to kickoff the 2016-17 school year. Students received forms and school information which will be important to them throughout the 2016-17 school year. They also received their lockers and combinations. A few reminders from the first week for all students:

Dress Code - Please adhere to the FHS Dress Code which includes wearing shorts of appropriate length, jeans without holes above the knees, and shirts and tops which are of appropriate length and adhere to the dress code. Tank tops and shirts which expose undergarments and/or a bare mid-drift are prohibited.

Back Packs-Back packs are permitted to and from school, but are not allowed to be carried during the school day. This includes string backpacks and any other type of bag
which is bigger than a typical handbag, which are approved. A student may carry a string backpack to gym, but must return it to their locker at the end of the period. As always, a student who has a medically approved reason for the backpack will be permitted to carry one, with an authorized letter from medical personnel.

Football Game Rules - Students are not permitted to carry backpacks to FHS Football games. Students who have backpacks will not be allowed entry into the game with a
backpack. Also, students are asked to be in the stands during play, and to not be loitering or running around at this time, as it detracts from other spectators enjoyment of the evening. Lastly, any ball (football or otherwise) brought into the stadium will be confiscated, as Falcon Stadium does not have room for pickup games of any kind. If your ball is confiscated, it can be returned to the student at the conclusion of the game. These rules are instituted for the safety and enjoyment of all the spectators. Come join the fun, but please follow these rules so the spectators can enjoy the team, cheerleaders, and marching band.
