ELECTRONIC REPORT CARDS

The first grading period at FHS ended last Friday, October 27th. Final grades are due from teachers in Power School by the end of school on Tuesday, October 31st,

Once grades have been verified that they are in the system, electronic report cards will be available to our students in Power School on Tuesday, November 7th. Please refer to your Power School account to access your

grade card. You will be able to print that report card on a 24/7 basis, as the electronic version is very similar to what students will see at LCCC and other colleges and universities which they will attend.

Students taking CCP classes will not have their grades available in Power School until the end of the first semester in early January. Since colleges are on a

Semester system, FHS students taking college classes will have to refer to their grades in-progress in their college on-line grading system.

Athletes who are playing a winter sport should print out their grade-in-progress and submit to your coach or Mr. Stillman for grade eligibility checks as soon as possible.

Just Short - Congratulations to the FHS Football team, cheerleaders, and MFMB on another successful fall season. Even though the Falcons were edged out of a playoff spot, the entire Firelands community is very proud of how our team, cheerleaders, and band performed over the last 10 weeks. The Falcons finished at 8-2, which equaled the record of the playoff bound 2015 squad. Over the last four years, the Class of 2018 finished with a record of 29-12, including the 2015 playoff berth. The Class of 2018 can also be proud of the fact that they finished above the .500 level all four years. Please congratulate the members of our football team, especially the seniors, whose hard work has paid off. Also, congratulate our senior band and cheerleaders who have also done a great job over the last four years. Congratulations Falcons on a wonderful season.

FALL SEASON COMPLETE -

Congratulations are also in order for our Boys and Girls Soccer teams, Volleyball team, and Golf team, who had fine seasons. The Boys Soccer team finished 6-3 in the PAC, while the Girls Soccer team ended the year at 6-2-1 in the PAC. The Volleyball team finished the year in the PAC at 7-9. All three teams finished in third place in the Stars Division of the PAC.

GOLF - PAC TOURNAMENT RUNNER-UP

Congratulations to the Falcons Golf team on their runner-up finish in the PAC Golf Championships, which allowed the team to finish 5th overall in PAC play.

CROSS-COUNTRY

The Boys Cross-Country team finished third in the PAC Championships, while the Girls finished 6th. Ian Valerius finished 5th in the PAC meet, while Alessandra Davis finished in fourth place in the Girls PAC meet. Davis also qualified for the Regional in Boardman this past Saturday and ran well, finishing in the middle of the pack as she was competing for a chance to qualify to the state meet in Hebron.
