You will be able to print that report card on a 24/7 basis, as the electronic version is very similar to what students will see at LCCC and other colleges and universities which they will attend.

Students taking CCP classes will not have their grades available in Power School until the end of the first semester in early January. Since colleges are on a Semester system, FHS students taking college classes will have to refer to their grades in-progress in their college on-line grading system. Athletes who are playing a winter sport should print out their grade-in-progress and submit to your coach or Mr. Stillman for grade eligibility checks as soon as possible.

CLEAR LEARNING TARGETS(CLT)

One of the main focus of delivering instruction at FHS is for the students to understand what their goal is, on a daily basis, that they should be learning in each class. Our teachers work with the state standards to align them to our curriculum so that the students of FHS understand what they should learn, and what they will be assessed on in each of their classes.

Learning targets are delivered to

the students in a variety of ways, but our teachers will always post and reinforce to the students what they should know at the end of each period.

Professor John Hattie has studied 138 different influences on student learning, and one of the top positive influences is for students to self-question their understanding of the instructional material. By utilizing clear learning targets, our students are given the ability to question if they truly understand the daily target. They are encouraged to ask questions and seek extra remediation if they are struggling to understand these daily targets. FHS students are given the opportunity in FAST and Wednesday Tutoring to receive extra help for the topics in which they are struggling.
