2018-19 PREPARATION UNDERWAY

As the school year settles into the second grading period, preparations are already underway for the release of the 2018-19 school calendar and course of study catalog, which will be available in January.

Over the past four years, FHS has offered over 50 hours of college credit through College Credit Plus and AP Calculus and Physics. Next year, FHS is preparing to add two more courses, which include AP Art and AP Chemistry. These courses are being considered so that students who have specific interests in those two fields can earn college credit in those specific areas.

These added courses would also up the offerings of college credits at FHS to near 60 hours, without ever leaving the FHS campus.

More details will be provided in the next few months as the course catalog becomes available, as our students will begin the scheduling process just after the second semester begins in mid-January.
