### SECOND GRADING PERIOD MIDTERMS - The

Students and parents should frequently check their Power School Access to ensure their progress in each class. Parents who do not have Power School access should contact their child's counselor, who can them set-up a parent account for them, or get them information to reset their existing account and/or password.

EOC GOVERNMENT TESTS - Students who are currently taking American Government (mostly 11th graders) are required by law to take the Ohio End-of-Course Government exam, which will be administered in their Block Period class on either December 13th or 14th, depending on when their class meets during block classes. This is the final Ohio EOC exam for most juniors.
