GOVERNMENT END-OF-COURSE EXAM

As the First Semester winds down, our FHS students who are currently taking Government will be taking the State of Ohio End-of-Course exam in American Government.

This exam, required by the Ohio Department of Education, is usually the final exam of the seven End-of-Course exams administered to our students. Students must score 18 total points on the seven

exams, taken over the course of their first three years in high school, to be eligible for a diploma.

Students should also know that the results of these End-of-Course exams are not denoted on their transcripts, which are sent to colleges and universities, when students are applying for both schools and scholarships.

These tests will be administered in the Government Block periods on Wednesday and Thursday, December 13th and 14th.

Students who need to re-take EOC exams in all subjects will be notified in school on Monday, December 4th, and will begin re-taking their exams beginning on Monday, December 11th.
