Students are reminded to return permission slips so that they can either arrive late, or leave early for their exams, as attendance during lunch and study hall periods is not required during these times, but students must have **SIGNED** parental permission to take advantage of the exam late arrival or early dismissal times.

FHS HIGHLIGHTS

FHS Highlights will be listed here each week to highlight different aspects of FHS Campus activities. Student achievements in the classroom, extra-curricular activities, and community events will be highlighted here, along with important information from both the FHS Main Office and the Athletic Department.

FALCON WRESTLERS FINISH WELL IN PERRYSBURG - Sophomore Payton Burgdorf defeated #7 ranked Jake Manley from Otsego to capture the title at 106 lbs in the highly competitive Perrysburg Invitational Tournament. Burgdorf has now won two straight tournaments over the holiday period, and is undefeated heading into PAC Wrestling matches this week. Senior Sean Lipscomb also captured the title at 285 lbs, as he won the championship bout 8-3 to capture the crown. The Falcons finished 11th overall in the 25 team tournament as they now set their sights on peaking for the PAC Championships at the end of the month.
