**PARKING PASSES** - Students can begin to apply for parking passes in the main office. All students must have a parking pass from FHS to park on campus. Cost is \$10. Passes must be obtained by Sept. 15th.

**BLOCK SCHEDULE STARTS SEPTEMBER 13TH** - Block Schedule Days begin on Wednesday, September 13th. Wednesday and Thursday Block Days allow our students to receive instruction in each of their classes for a 94 minute period, with some classes held on a Wednesday, while the others are held on Thursdays. The schedule is posted on the FHS website and can be accessed by [clicking here](#). Wednesday's also include a 45-minute Teacher Tutoring session, from 8:15 - 9 am, where students may visit teachers where they would like some more 1-1 instruction. Some students will be assigned to a teacher tutoring session. This is mandatory instructional time for students who are assigned to this period, but optional for other students. Parents will be notified if the time for their student is mandatory. A study hall will be available for students who arrive to school before 9 am each day.

## CURRICULUM CORNER

As the school year begins, many students and parents ask about the graduation requirements from the End-of-Course Exams that students must take under Ohio Revised Code. The exams are given in the spring under these seven tested areas:

English I, English II, Algebra, Geometry, Biology, US History, and Government (also tested in December). If your student is

taking one or more of these courses, they will be taking that exam in the Spring. To graduate, students must qualify in one of three ways, and earn 23 credits through FHS in order to be eligible to graduate, under ORC and Firelands Board Policy. The three ways are:

1. Earn 18 points on the seven tests, and also score at least 4 points in English, 4 points in

Math, and 6 in Science/Soc Studies

2. Earn a remediation free score on either the ACT or SAT in English, Reading, and Math  
3. Earn a industry credential and score proficient on the Work Keys (Available at LCJVS)
