HUNGER SIMULATION - On Tuesday, February 6th, Firelands FFA will be hosting a Hunger Breakfast simulation to educate students at Firelands High School. Around seventy students that were identified as leaders in their school will attend the breakfast. **Upon arrival, each student will be labeled with a fictitious name, economic status, and situation and then put into the Upper Class, Middle Class, Low Class, or Poverty.** They will also be given a certain amount of paper money depending on their economic status, with the High Class receiving the most and the students in Poverty receiving none at all. Everyone will receive a menu of the food being served and the cost of each item. As the breakfast goes on, there will be situations that will change the cost of different items that are able to be purchased, either making them rise or fall. The students will face the reality of everyday and some will see how it truly feels to be hungry, while others will experience having more than enough to meet their needs. This Hunger Breakfast will show the leaders in Firelands High School that hunger **IS** an issue in their community and will help them to think of ways they can begin to fight the problem in their own school.

HOW TO PRINT YOUR REPORT CARDS

Students now have 24/7 access to their official report cards in Power School. Some students have inquired as to how to access a hard copy, and it is as simple as 1-2-3.

1. Log onto your Power School account
2. Click on Report Card on the left hand side of the page. It is the third choice from the top.

3. Hit the printer icon on the top right of the page, where you can route the printing to any printer for which you have access.

Students have access to print their report card throughout the school year. We encourage all our students to utilize this very simple process.

If you would like access to your

transcripts for college or career purposes, you should request that printout in the School Counseling Office as it is important for our students to know where they stand at all times in terms of graduation progress and beyond.
