FALCON SHOWCASE IS TUESDAY

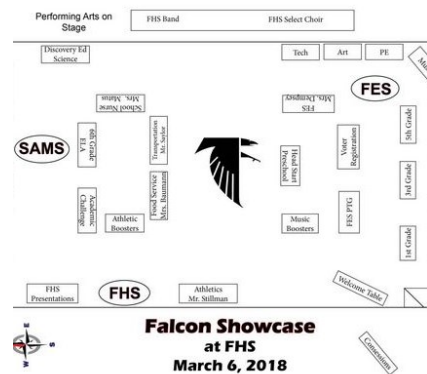

POWER SCHOOL ACCESS - ENHANCED

This announcement is for all of our students at FHS. Power School access for parents and students has been upgraded and enhanced, so that our students and parents have 24/7 access to their entire student achievement record.

After logging into your Power School account, most students will utilize the ability to check their current grades, but everyone should be aware there is so much

more in their account.

Students can access their current grades and attendance, report cards for current and previous school years, email access to your student's teachers, school fee balances, and just added, access to state End-of-Course and College Entrance Exam scores, and a Graduation Pathway check

The Graduation Pathway will allow students to see if they have met one of the three criteria mandated by the State of Ohio to qualify for graduation. This is a good check for students who should be aware of their progress on Ohio End-of-Course exams, College testing, or Workforce Credentials (usually through the LCJVS). Please contact the counseling office if you need access to this account.

CHOIR MOVES ON TO STATE COMPETITION - Over the last two weeks, the Firelands Choral program has been very successful, culminating in a Superior rating at the OMEA District Competition on Friday at Elyria, qualifying them to State Competition. Also, Lorain County Solo and Ensemble had FHS compete in 26 group, scoring 18 Superior ratings, 7 excellent ratings, and 1 good rating! WRESTLING SENDS TWO TO COLUMBUS - The Firelands Wrestling program had their first ever District Champion in 106 lbs Sophomore Payton Burgdorf, who qualifies for his second consecutive State Wrestling Championship tournament. He will

be joined in Columbus by Sean Lipscomb, who finished third at 285 lbs and will be participating in his first State Tournament.
