ELA END-OF-COURSE TESTING NEXT WEEK - All students taking English I or English II will be taking part in Ohio End-of-Course testing on **Monday and Tuesday, April 16th and 17th**. Students must achieve 18 points on seven EOC tests to be eligible for graduation. Testing on ELA will be over two days, with tests **beginning at 7:30 am** and lasting until 9:30 am. **Students who are not enrolled in those courses are not required to be at school until a 9:30 am start time, as FHS will be on a two-hour delay schedule next Monday and Tuesday.** Lists will be posted in school near the end of the week informing students of their testing areas. These tests are important for our students as they accumulate points toward graduation status. Good luck to all our students as they prepare to take the EOC ELA I or ELA II tests.
