STUDENTS ACCESSING TECHNOLOGY

As the year progresses, students sometime forget their password to either their Google Account, or their FHS School account, which allows them access to Power School.

Please note, these **accounts are different**, and will have a different log-in and password. Also, students who need a reset can reset their Google password on any device, but if a password reset

is needed for Power School, they will have to complete that process on an FHS Computer in the Library Media Center, one of the Computer Labs, or a wired computer in a teacher's classroom. You **CANNOT** reset your Power School password on any other device by a wired, school computer.

If you need a reset, your teachers have access to a form

that can be submitted to reset your password. The process takes a few minutes before your password is remotely reset. The reset password for both is: **Firelands2017! This is CASE SENSATIVE.** Usernames for both are **lastname+last three digits of Student ID**. For Google, you must add **@firelands.k12.us** after your username to access Google.
