
## **PROM WEEK IS HERE**

**UPON US -** The Baseball, Softball, and Track teams are gearing up for Sectional and District Tournament action, as the calendar has turned to May and OHSAA Tournaments are upon us.

**Baseball** - The Baseball team is an impressive 20-3 on the season (13-0 in the PAC ) and have won the PAC Stars Division title. Congratulations to the players and Coach Ransom as the Falcons have also earned the #1 seed in the Division II District Tournament, and open play on Wednesday, May 9th against the winner of the Bay-Buckeye matchup, which will be played on Tuesday. The Falcons will play at home at 5 pm on Wednesday, and will advance to District Semi-Final play next week at CCC West in Parma with a win. Go Falcons!

**Softball** - The Girls Softball team also opens tournament play this week as the #4 seed in the Division II District Tournament.
