CONGRATS TO OUR SPECIAL OLYMPIANS - Congratulations to our Firelands Special Olympians, who competed in the 2018 Special Olympics at Ely Stadium last Friday. On a cold, raw day, our Falcons showed spirit and determination on a day that spells out the best that friendly competition brings to all of us.

SPRING TOURNAMENT SEASON IS UPON US - The Baseball, Softball, and Track teams are gearing up for District Tournament action, as the calendar has turned to May and OHSAA Tournaments are upon us.

Baseball - The Baseball team used a walk-off win to defeat PAC rival Buckeye, 5-4, last week to advance to Tuesday's District Semi-Final game against Rocky River. The game begins at 4:30 pm at CCC West in Parma.

Softball - The Softball team used a solid effort

to defeat Fairview, 5-0, last week to advance to the District Semi-Finals at LaGrange Community Park against Keystone. The game is Thursday evening at 5 pm

Track - The Track teams competed in the PAC Track Championships last week at Oberlin College. The Girls team finished a solid 5th, while the boys finished 4th, both out of the 12 teams in the PAC. Congratulations to PAC Champion, Senior Sean Lipscomb in the Discus, as he threw the discus 128'. Also, congratulations to Blake Ruffner on his two runner-up finishes in the high jump, where he jumped 6'6", and also in the 400m dash, where his 52.00 seconds was also good enough for second place. The track team travels to Orrville High School on Thursday and Saturday to compete in the Division II District Track meet, with the top four placers in each event qualifying to the Regional Meet next week in Lexington.
