

FHS HIGHLIGHTS

FHS Highlights will be listed here each week to highlight different aspects of FHS Campus activities. Student achievements in the classroom, extra-curricular activities, and community events will be highlighted here, along with important information from both the FHS Main Office and the Athletic Department.

BASEBALL - 2018 DIVISION II DISTRICT CHAMPIONS - The Falcon

Baseball team captured their first ever Division II District Baseball Championship last Wednesday afternoon with a 5-3 victory over Padua at Mottl Field at CCC West. The Falcons were led by pitcher Evan Lacey, who went the distance for the win, throwing six shutout innings at the Bruins, before shutting down the Bruin rally in the 7th inning. The Falcons manufactured five runs, with the big hit of the day coming off the bat of sophomore Grant Price, who laced a two-out single in the fourth inning, giving the Falcons a 2-0 lead. Firelands added three more in the fifth inning for a 5-0 lead.

All this was made possible in a wild Semi-Final game, won by the Falcons 9-8 in 8 innings. Down 8-7 in the seventh, senior Aaron Myers delivered a huge game tying 2-out, 2-strike RBI double, scoring Jacob Mullins to send the

game to extra-innings. In the eighth inning, Calvin Stull sent the Falcons to the Championship game with a walk-off single, giving the Falcons their second straight tournament walk-off win.

Firelands travels to Carter Park in Bowling Green for a 2 pm battle with top ranked Wapakoneta in a Regional Semi-Final game. Admission for the Regional game is \$7.

TRACK DISTRICT - Congratulations to Blake Ruffner for winning the Division II District High Jump with a winning jump of 6'4". Ruffner advances to the Regional at Lexington in the High Jump, and also in the 400 m Dash. Other Falcons to advance to Lexington were Peyton Phillips in both the 100m and 300 m hurdles, Mackenzie Allsop in the 800 m run, Alessandra Davis in the 1600 m run, and the Boys 4 x 200 m relay and Boys 4 x 400 m relay teams (Alex Angle, Beau Grude, Blake Ruffner, and Logan Strader). The Falcons will travel to Lexington on Thursday for the Regional Semi-Finals, and could return on Saturday for the Regional Finals, attempting to qualify for the State Meet at Ohio State. Admission to the Regional Meet is \$7 for all spectators.
