Conferences are on a first-come, first serve basis on each day. If parents feel they need longer than a 10-minute time period with a teacher, they should contact the specific teacher to set-up a longer conference on a non-conference date, if possible. Parents will also be receiving an all-call from FHS reminding them of these two dates.

**PSAT UPCOMING** - Tenth grade students who are either identified as gifted, or are taking at least one honors or CCP class will be taking the PSAT on Wednesday, October 11th, beginning at 9 am. Juniors who took the PSAT last year and scored in the 70th percentile will also be able to take the PSAT again on the same date. This test fee has been covered by a grant received by FHS to enable our students to partake in a practice college exam, and to receive data and test taking information that will further prepare them for both the SAT and/or the ACT. Juniors who score at a high enough rate, and have taken the test as a sophomore, could qualify to become National Merit Semi-Finalists, and could be considered for the National Merit Scholarship Program. The test will be given to the students mentioned above in different venues in Firelands High School.
