The Firelands High School Graduating Class of 2017 continued a trend of ACT scores that are well above the State of Ohio average in all subject areas tested and composite ACT score, which is at an all-time FHS high. The Class of 2017 recorded an average Composite Score of 22.7, beating the previous high mark from the Class of 2015 by 0.1 points. FHS is also happy to announce that the Class of 2017 had 38% of the students who took the ACT last year meet the College Readiness Benchmarks in all four college level coursework areas, which are College English Composition, College Algebra, College Social Science, College Biology. That exceeds the state mark of 33% and is also an all-time high of success for the students of FHS.
