Planning for the Future Board Places a Bond Issue on the November Ballot to **Construct a New 9-12 High School**

On July 17th the Board of Education voted unanimously to place a 4.28 mill bond issue on the November ballot to construct a new high school. The new building will be built on district owned property and will be connected to the current high school located on Vermilion Road in Henrietta Township.

This vote was a culmination of the efforts by community members, parents and staff who served on the building advisory committee last fall and winter, and of the extensive feedback we received from our main stakeholders. Once constructed, our existing high school will be repurposed as the district's middle school and Board Office, and South Amherst Middle School will be closed.

The new building will serve as the entry point for students and visitors, providing increased safety and security for all students in grades 6-12. A central kitchen and

The Communities we serve: Amherst, Amherst Twp, Birmingham, Brownhelm Twp, Camden Twp, Florence Twp, Henrietta Twp, Kipton Village, New Russia Twp, South Amherst Village, Vermilion and Vermilion Twp. cafeteria will also be constructed to maximize resources and serve both middle and high school students.

As educators, we know new school buildings are important for providing safe and productive learning environments. But we also know the positive impact up-todate schools have on our communities - securing property values and strengthening our local economy.

We can no longer sit back and ignore the urgent need to address our facilities. Our middle school is 108 years old and continually causes educational and financial challenges. While challenges in our other facilities are not far behind, we know we have to start by addressing our greatest needs first and that's why we have put forth this plan.

Additional Personnel Hired to Enhance Student and Staff Safety

In cooperation with the Lorain County Sheriff's Department, our Board of Education has approved the addition of a full-time school resource officer. I am pleased to announce that Sheriff Stamitti has selected Deputy Cody Northeim, FHS Class of 2012, to serve as our school resource officer.

In addition to enhancing the physical safety of our students, we also understand meeting the mental health needs of our students is of critical importance. Through collaboration with the Educational Service Center of Lorain County, we will also be adding a part-time school social worker for this school year. Mrs. Doris Woodwards-Davila, our new school social worker, comes to us from Applewood Centers Inc. where she worked as a school based clinical supervisor.

Each day we strive to ensure that all students achieve and grow academically, socially and emotionally. As the school year approaches, many of you will be making day care arrangements for your children. PLEASE KEEP THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE IN MIND TO HELP INSURE THE SAFETY OF THE CHILDREN.

always best, but we realize, it is not always possible. When a change for pick up or drop off is necessary, we are asking you to adhere to the following procedure: PLEASE HAVE ALL FORMS TURNED IN BY AUGUST 21, 2018 TO BE EFFECTIVE BY THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.

These forms are designed for permanent or steady route changes.

- WITH THE SAFETY OF YOUR CHILD IN MIND, VARIABLE AND ALTERNATING DAYS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED
- \Rightarrow PLEASE HAVE VARIANCE FORMS COMPLETED AND TURNED INTO THE SCHOOL OR BUS GARAGE 5 DAYS PRI-OR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATES, SO EVERYONE INVOLVED MAY HAVE PROPER NOTICE OF THE CHANGE.

SAYLER @ 965-4105 TO SEE IF A POSSI-**BLE ALTERNATE BUS ROUTE IS AVAILABLE 24 HOURS IN** ADVANCE. IF THIS ONE TIME CHANGE IS APPROVED, PAR-ENTS ALSO NEED TO SEND A NOTE WITH THE CHILD TO BE GIVEN TO THE BUS DRIVER UPON BOARDING. IF MR. SAYLER DOES NOT HAVE SPACE AVAILABLE ON A PARTICULAR BUS ROUTE OR IF A CHILD DOES NOT BRING A NOTE, THE ONE-TIME, TEMPORARY ROUTE CHANGE WILL BE REFUSED OUT OF SAFETY CONCERNS.

2018 - 2019 FIRELANDS BUS ROUTES SCHOOL BUS STOP

Welcome to the start of the 2018-2019 school year. Some general information AHEAD along with the routes is provided for you here. Students that do not ride the bus to school on the first day will need to check with their teacher or the office to find the correct bus number to ride home in the afternoon. Please do not assume that they ride the same bus home as last year as several of the bus numbers have changed. You will find the A.M. routes listed by township, bus driver, driver's name and bus number. If the Bus that arrives at your house is different than what is published, the driver will instruct the students of the proper number. Please remember these times are approximate and may vary especially the first week or two of school. We ask that you have your child ready ahead of time, and wait for the bus in a safe location, approximately 10 feet from the road. There will continue to be an emphasis on designated place of safety both before and after school. Even students on the right hand side need to stay back away from the edge of the road and wait until the bus driver signals them before students approach the bus. For those who need to cross the road, please wait for the drivers hand signal before crossing and check traffic on your own.

All Firelands students in grades 6 - 12 will be transported on the High School/Middle School Routes and grades K - 5 will be transported on the elementary routes. St. Joe's students will be transported on our High School/Middle School routes A.M. and P.M., Open Door will be transported on the A.M. High School routes and P.M. Elementary Routes.

For elementary students only, post cards will be sent out approximately one week before school with bus numbers and times to alleviate phone calls. All of the information listed here will be available on the Firelands Website: http://www.firelandsschools.org, under the Central Office tab / Transportation along with the variance form procedure and a printable variance form for your convenience.

To start the school year off there will be no detours however, Route 60 North of Route 113 is scheduled for construction October 1st. More information to follow as it becomes available.



SCHOOL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 2018 - 2019

It is now time to update your child's immunizations. If your child will be entering school for the first time, or after attending school elsewhere, please be sure to check that he/she is in compliance with State of Ohio immunization requirements:

<u>Kindergarten</u> – once your child has reached age 4, s/he can complete all required immunizations for diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus (DPT), polio (IPV), hepatitis B (HBV), measles mumps, rubella (MMR), and varicella (chickenpox). If possible, have them done and bring a copy of the record to Kindergarten screening on May 23, 2018.

- Grades 1-6 same requirements as for Kindergarten
- Grades 7-9 Grades K-6 requirements plus Tdap (DPT booster) and MCV (meningococcal vaccine)
- <u>Grades 10-11</u> Grades K-6 requirements plus Tdap (received in 7th grade or later)
- <u>Grade 12</u> Grades 10-11 requirements plus MCV (must be received at age 16 or older)

Remember to bring your child's immunization records with you when you go to your healthcare provider or clinic. Please send a copy of the immunization record to the school nurse in your child's building, being sure your child's name is on it. Don't forget to keep a copy for yourself!

Lorain County Public Health, 9880 S. Murray Ridge Rd., Elyria, OH 44035 is now offering immunizations (also known as vaccines) Monday through Friday, 8:30 am – 3:30 pm, with evening hours throughout the month. A full vaccine clinic schedule is available at

www.LorainCountyHealth.com. Appointments are encouraged, although walk-ins are accepted. Call 440-284-3206 for information or to make an appointment for both children and adults. Bring all immunization records, insurance cards, and cash or check; although some children may be eligible for discounts under the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program. All children under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Note: Ask your provider about additional vaccines that are recommended for children ages 11-19 such as 2nd dose of varicella (chickenpox), hepatitis A and human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccines. de Firelands Express
