FIRST SEMESTER EXAM SCHEDULE – Semester Exams begin this week, starting on Wednesday, December 18th. Linked here is a schedule for First Semester Exams here at FHS. Semester Exams are worth 20% of the student's Semester Grade, and should be taken at the time listed. Students at the JVS or LCCC will have to make arrangements with their FHS teacher for exams if times conflict. Students are excused from school at the conclusion of the final test on each day, and do not have to stay for lunch. However, lunch will be provided, and if students must stay, a quiet study hall will be provided for them. Busses will run at the regular time each day. ART STUDENTS TO COLUMBUS – Congratulations to Mrs. Tawil and her Art Students who created ornaments for the National Christmas Tree in Washington DC. Firelands was the only school in Ohio selected for this great honor. The students were also honored on the floor of the Statehouse last Wednesday with a proclamation, and will again be honored by the Firelands Board of Education at their regular meeting on Monday evening, January 13th. It was a very proud moment for our students, staff, parents, and entire community.

OHIO END-OF-COURSE TESTING – Fall End-of-Course testing has concluded, except for a few students who need to make up a test. Spring testing for much of the high school will occur in late March through early May.

FFA HOLIDAY CALENDAR – The FHS FFA Students have created a Holiday Calendar of giving, letting all our students know that giving is the way to celebrate the holidays. The challenge is for each student to complete at least five days of tasks on the calendar. Some examples are: write a thank you letter to a serviceman or woman or first responder; call a relative just to say hi and talk; stop a negative conversation, donate a toy, etc. The calendar is located at the front of the school, and students who complete a task should initial the date of the activity. Thank you to our FFA program and students for promoting giving to our entire FHS community.
