PRESIDENT'S DAY – NO SCHOOL ON MONDAY, FEBRUARY 17TH – FHS will be closed for President's Day next Monday, February 17th. School will reopen on Tuesday at 7:30, beginning with FAST. Next week will be a normal bell schedule week, with regular block periods on Tuesday and Wednesday.

FHS CAREER READINESS FAIR AND PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES – Firelands High School will host Parent-Teacher conferences in teacher classrooms from 3 – 6:30 pm on Thursday, February 20th. Also, the FHS Student Services Department will be hosting the first annual Career Readiness Fair for students and parents at 4 pm that date in the FHS Cafeteria. Come join us for career information from over 20 local employers, which will run from 4-6 pm that afternoon.

JUNIOR SAT DAY – WENDESDAY, MARCH 4TH – The Ohio Department of Education provides the SAT to all juniors, free of charge. The SAT testing date will be on Wednesday, March 4th, with testing beginning at 7:30 am on that date. This is a mandatory test for all juniors, including students attending the LCJVS and CCP full-day students at both Lorain County Community College and BG-Firelands. Student in the other three grades will not have class that day at Firelands High School. Students in grades 9, 10, and 12 should use the day to shadow career interests, or make it a college visit day. The SAT should end that day about noon. They will be excused at that time. Lunch will be provided, but is not required. Students who receive testing accommodations will test that date until approximately 1:30 pm. Please check with your student to see if they will receive special testing accommodations. Students will begin to pre-register for the SAT in class, and counselors will travel to the JVS to pre-register our students who attend school there. Again, this is a mandatory test for all juniors, regardless of what school they attend (LCCC, FHS, LCJVS). Please contact our school counseling office if you need further details.

FALCON SHOWCASE - Come join us on Tuesday, March 10th for the Falcon Showcase, which is student-focused and is a direct reflection of their hard work and dedication. This is an excellent opportunity for the community to see the quality instruction within our buildings, and what the students have produced.

New this year, any student with an existing business is welcome to display and sell their product. For example: students who produce maple syrup, jewelry etc. The students need to pre-register with Jen Butchko or Lori Roemer by Friday, February 14th.

Tables and designated areas will be set up for students to display/demonstrate their accomplishments, all in the friendly confines of the Firelands High School gymnasium.

The Lady Falcons have one more regular season game, tomorrow at Lorain, as they prepare for the Division II District Basketball Tournament, earning the #3 seed and a first round bye. The Lady Falcons will host the winner of the first round matchup between Fairview and East Technical on Thursday evening, February 20th, at 7 pm. Please remember, only OHSAA passes are accepted for tournament game, and ticket prices are \$7 for adults, and \$5 for students, with all tickets at the door. Congratulations to Coach Kudela and his staff on a fantastic season as they look to make a run in the OHSAA tournament.

OHSAA TOURNAMENT TIME – The Wrestling team participated in the OHSAA Division II Dual Meet Tournament yesterday, with the Falcons wrestling in Brookside Region. The #7 seeded Falcons defeated #10 Cleveland Central Catholic, but fell in the Regional Quarter-Finals to #2 seeded Bay in a tight contest.
