GOOGLE CLASS CODES FOR FHS STUDENTS – Each Class (Freshman, Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors) will have their own Class Codes for class informational purposes, and to have the ability to vote for Class Officers, Homecoming Court, and other items that will be beneficial to our students. PSAT TESTING AT FHS – Firelands High School will be hosting the PSAT test for all 9th and 10th grade students on Wednesday, October 16th, beginning at 7:30 am. Also, Juniors who want to take the PSAT again, and is an excellent practice test for the SAT in March. Juniors must sign-up with Dr. Zimmer in Student Services prior to September 16th. As a reminder, the testing ends at approximately noon, and students will be dismissed from school at that time. Any student who must ride the bus, will have a quiet study hall available to them after the conclusion of lunch, which will be served to all students who would like to have lunch following the conclusion of the PSAT.

HOMECOMING FESTIVITIES – Homecoming Weekend starts on Thursday, September 26th with the annual Football Jersey auction, which coincides with a SAMS doubleheader in Falcon Stadium. The Athletic Booster Club will be hosting that event. Friday evening, the Homecoming Game against Black River will begin at 7pm, with the crowning ceremony of the King and Queen beginning around 6 pm. The Homecoming Dance, with the theme of It's a Beach Homecoming, will be held from 7-10 pm in the Falcon Gymnasium on Saturday evening, September 28th. Tickets will go on sale in the next few weeks, with dance tickets \$10 pre-sale and \$15 at the door. Students bringing an out-of- school guest must have the out-of-school guest form approved by FHS Administration prior to the purchase of the guest's ticket. The form is available on the FHS website. All guests must be in at least 9th grade, and under the age of 21. Any students not in high school must be a graduate of Firelands High School to attend the Homecoming Dance.

JOIN THE FIRELANDS ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB – The Firelands Athletic Boosters are another way to support our student-athletes at FHS. People can sign up by completing the FABC form, which are available in Student Services and at the football concession stand. Membership of two years gives your student- athlete an opportunity to earn FABC scholarships, pending a completed application.

JVS STUDENT INFORMATION MEETING – Mr. Maver and Mrs. Keener met with the FHS students who are attending the LCJVS on Friday morning, September 6th, to give them information on how to stay informed as a JVS student with the events happening at FHS. Students were given and informational sheet, which is also posted on the FHS website, as to major events upcoming at FHS. They were also given class join codes, which are used to communicate with all of the classes at FHS through their Google Classroom Class accounts. The share codes were listed above in this flyer.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM - The Firelands School District is excited to inform our parents/guardians about our communication tool (Google Classroom). The purpose of Google Classroom is to provide communication from the classroom teacher to home. The staff has been trained and will use this tool to communicate classroom activities, upcoming classroom events, and other important information happening within the classroom.

Parents will be invited to join the teacher's link to view the Google Classroom site. This is expected to go live by Friday, September 13th. Parents will be able to get weekly updates, or daily updates, based on your preference. This is why an accurate email address from input into OneView is imperative so we can invite you to Google Classroom.

If more than one parent email is requested for Google Classroom access, just email the specific teacher and they can add an email address for parent access.

COLLEGE NOW AT FHS – A college counselor from College Now will be at FHS every other Tuesday to further assist our students in the college search process. They can answer questions about the search, application, and financial aid process.

SCHOOL SCHEDULES AND ACCOUNT ACCESS – Students can access Power School using their log-in code of Last Name + Last three digits of their student ID. The password will be the student's six digit ID Number. For example, Joe Smith has an ID of 123456. His username would be Smith456 and the Password would be 123456. The Power School website is accessible through the Firelands Local Schools webpage.

To access student Google Accounts, the student will log into their account. The username is the same as above, but the password for everyone in Google is Firelands2019. The system will prompt you for a password reset upon your initial log-in. This will allow students to access all of their Google information, and school email.

All students should be able to access their Power School and Google accounts. If they cannot, they should inform a staff member, who can pass the information along to our technology people so they can obtain access to their accounts.

If a parent would like their own Power School account, and do not yet have one, please email Mr. Maver at maver@firelandsschools.org. This will allow parents to link their students throughout the district, provided they have the access codes for each student, into one account. Power School is where official grades are stored and viewed.

ONEVIEW – STUDENT PAPERWORK – Firelands Local School District will continue to use OneView to update our back- to-school forms. From your web browser, go to our homepage at: http://www.firelandsschools.org and click on Student Registration. Then follow the link for the Firelands OneView Portal at https://firelands.esvportal.com/. If you can access OneView with your username and password, follow the directions below to update the information for the 2019-20 school year. Each child's parents/guardians have received a one-page mailer with OneView Username and Password information, which will be necessary if you cannot access your OneView account. That will help you log onto the system.

After you have logged into OneView, select the "Submit & View Online Forms" tab. Under the 2019-2020 Back To School Forms banner, please complete and submit the "Student Demographic and EMA" form. As a reminder, if you have multiple children enrolled in Firelands, you must complete this form separately for each child.

In order to ensure we have your child's most accurate health history and emergency contact information, we ask that all forms be completed as soon as possible. You can, at any time throughout the year, update new phone numbers, email addresses, etc. If you need assistance with your account, please contact the FHS Main Office for assistance. This is also how we communicate through email, as it is vital to have accurate email addresses. One more item, if you have changed your any information, please update it in OneView and also email Mrs. Dziat to let her know of the changes. Her email address is kdziat@firelandsschools.org
