MIDTERM IS HERE – Believe it or not, we have just finished our 4th week of school. This would be a good time for your student and you to sit down and look at their progress in the first grading period. You are always welcome, and encouraged to contact your student's teacher about any questions you may have regarding your student's education. We also encourage our students to advocate for themselves and ask their teacher's questions about their progress in class. As a reminder, Parent-Teacher Conferences at FHS will be held on Wednesday, October 2nd, and Thursday, October 10th from 3-7 pm on both evenings. Also please note, that all progress is recorded in the student's Power School account, as FHS has gone completely digital in order for your student to be able to access their information 24/7.

MEAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION -An updated meal assistance application must be filled out every school year if you wish to receive or continue with benefits. We have an online portal which is the preferred method. You can complete an application at http://www.payschoolscentral.com. Direct Certification letters must be signed and returned to waive instructional school fees, do not fill out an application. A paper application can be printed from the Food Service tab on the school website or each school office has paper applications available. If your child received meal assistance last year that status will roll over until Sept. 30th if a new application has not been received. On Sept 30th the meal status will automatically change to denied if an updated application is not received.

PSAT TESTING AT FHS – All FHS Freshman and Sophomores, and 75 Juniors who have signed up will be taking the PSAT test at FHS on **Wednesday morning, October 16**th, beginning at 7:30 am. This is a mandatory day of school for all Freshman and Sophomores, and the 75 Juniors who have signed up for the test. The PSAT 9 is a great personal assessment tool for 9th graders, and the PSAT/NMSQT for the 10th and 11th graders is an excellent tool to prepare for the PSAT and to possibly qualify for scholarships. All Freshman and Sophomores at the JVS should report to FHS that day, and will not be required to return in the afternoon. The test should end that day around 11:45, with lunch available to all students after testing. Students are excused from school at the end of the PSAT. Juniors and Seniors who are not testing are expected to use the day as a college visit, job shadow, or career/military exploration. For students who cannot get an early ride home, busses will run at the normal time of 2:30 pm, and a study hall will be provided for students who have to ride the bus home.

HOMECOMING FESTIVITIES – Homecoming Weekend starts on Thursday, September 26th with the annual Football Jersey auction, which coincides with a SAMS doubleheader in Falcon Stadium. The Athletic Booster Club will be hosting that event. Friday evening, the Homecoming Game against Black River will begin at 7pm, with the crowning ceremony of the King and Queen beginning around 6 pm. The Homecoming Dance, with the theme of It's a Beach Homecoming, will be held from 7-10 pm in the Falcon Gymnasium on Saturday evening, September 28th. Tickets are on sale now, with dance tickets \$10 pre-sale and \$15 at the door. Student guest forms were due by last week Any students not in high school must be a graduate of Firelands High School to attend the Homecoming Dance.

In each class' Google Classroom, students are now able to vote for Prince and Princess of their respective classes. The entire school votes for Homecoming King and Queen. All voting takes place through Google Classroom. The Class Prince and Princesses are announced at the Homecoming Pep Rally on Friday afternoon. JVS Students are invited, and the JVS Bus will leave the JVS early that day so our FHS students at the JVS can attend the Pep Rally.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM FOR PARENTS – Google Classroom emails from teachers to parents is how active. Parents will be able to get a weekly email from a teachers Google Classroom, and if they have a Google Account, will be able to customize this to receive daily updates from the teachers through an email generated from Google Classroom. Only the students have access to their teacher's Google Classroom, as that is where many assignments are collected.

Students taking CCP Classes will not be utilizing Google Classroom, as LCCC utilizes Canvas, which is their prescribed student portal for assignments and grades.

FFA PERFORMS WELL AT SOILS COMPETITION – The Rural Soils Team earned 4th in the tri-county contest, keeping scores close to some of the toughest teams in the state. They were 1st in county. Chance Coultrip was 6th in tri-county, 1st in county & Noah Galloway ended up 2nd in county.

The Urban Soils Team moved all the way up to 2nd in tri-county just behind one of the strongest teams in the state! They won county and Kaleb Carver took 3rd in tri-county & 1st in county while Krystal Scheeres landed 5th in the tri-county & 2nd in county.

The teams will be hosting and competing in the district contest this Thursday.
