PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCE – OCTOBER 2ND & **10TH** – Wednesday, October 2nd, and Thursday, October 10th, FHS will be hosting Parent-Teacher Conferences from 3 – 6:30 pm each day, on a first-come, first-serve basis in teacher classrooms. This is a good way to talk to your student's teacher about their progress, and any suggestions the teacher may have for improved progress. We ask that you limit your conference to 10-minutes per teacher, so that others may have a chance to meet with the teachers. There will be a map at the front door of FHS upon your arrival.

SENIOR GRADUATION ORDERS – Jostens was here on Thursday to meet with the Seniors about Senior Year Graduation Orders. From announcements, to grad gear, to the most important item, Caps and Gowns, Jostens gave all Seniors Graduation packets at the meeting on Thursday. They will be returning to FHS on Tuesday during lunch periods to take any early graduation orders. There will also be a dedicated FHS Class of 2020 Website from Jostens, which will not be active until next week. The website will be linked on the FHS Website, and placed in the weekly Flyer update. Students at the JVS will have a separate meeting with Jostens in November, and have their Caps and Gowns delivered to them at the JVS. FHS Caps and Gowns will be delivered in the spring.

MEAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION -An updated meal assistance application must be filled out every school year if you wish to receive or continue with benefits. We have an online portal which is the preferred method. You can complete an application at http://www.payschoolscentral.com. Direct Certification letters must be signed and returned to waive instructional school fees, do not fill out an application. A paper application can be printed from the Food Service tab on the school website or each school office has paper applications available. If your child received meal assistance last year that status will roll over until Sept. 30th if a new application has not been received. On Sept 30th the meal status will automatically change to denied if an updated application is not received.

Online payments / Account payments

Online payments can be made at www.payschoolscentral.com. This site can also be used for the reporting system to view what your child has purchased as well. The reports can be seen at no cost to you. There is a small convenience fee to use for online payments.

PSAT TESTING AT FHS – All FHS Freshman and Sophomores, and 75 Juniors who have signed up will be taking the PSAT test at FHS on **Wednesday morning, October 16**th, beginning at 7:30 am. This is a mandatory day of school for all Freshman and Sophomores, and the 75 Juniors who have signed up for the test. The PSAT 9 is a great personal assessment tool for 9th graders, and the PSAT/NMSQT for the 10th and 11th graders is an excellent tool to prepare for the PSAT and to possibly qualify for scholarships. All Freshman and Sophomores at the JVS should report to FHS that day, and will not be required to return in the afternoon. The test should end that day around 11:45, with lunch available to all students after testing. Students are excused from school at the end of the PSAT. Juniors and Seniors who are not testing are expected to use the day as a college visit, job shadow, or career/military exploration. For students who cannot get an early ride home, busses will run at the normal time of 2:30 pm, and a study hall will be provided for students who have to ride the bus home.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM TIP PARENTS – You should be now receiving Google Classroom updates, at least once per week on a Friday, if you have accepted the invitation to the Classroom. This is an informational email, reviewing things done during the week. If you have a Google account, you can set this to receive daily updates, as a Google account affords people the ability to have more flexibility in how they receive these emails.

The Classrooms themselves are only for students, as they are only accessible through a student's FHS Google account. Please email me if you are not receiving these updates, as the weekly updates come at 4 pm on Friday afternoon's, a time that is pre-set by Google.

Students taking CCP Classes will not be utilizing Google Classroom, as LCCC utilizes Canvas, which is their prescribed student portal for assignments and grades.
